

# Joshua 1:8 Scriptures

1. **Joshua 1:8 (NLT)** <sup>8</sup> Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do.
2. **Romans 6:4 (NLT)** <sup>4</sup> For we died and were buried with Christ by baptism. And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives.
3. **Galatians 2:20 (NLT)** <sup>20</sup> My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
4. **Romans 12:1 (NLT)** <sup>1</sup> And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.
5. **John 14:21 (NLT)** <sup>21</sup> **Those who accept my commandments and obey them are the ones who love me. And because they love me, my Father will love them. And I will love them and reveal myself to each of them.**
6. **2 Timothy 3:16 (NLT)** <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right.
7. **John 15:7 (NLT)** <sup>7</sup> **But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted!**
8. **Philippians 4:4–7 (NLT)** <sup>4</sup> Always be full of joy in the Lord. I say it again—rejoice! <sup>5</sup> Let everyone see that you are considerate in all you do. Remember, the Lord is coming soon. <sup>6</sup> Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. <sup>7</sup> Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.
9. **Proverbs 27:17 (NLT)** <sup>17</sup> As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend.
10. **Hebrews 10:24–25 (NLT)** <sup>24</sup> Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. <sup>25</sup> And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.
11. **Matthew 4:19 (NLT)** <sup>19</sup> Jesus called out to them, **“Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!”**
12. **Romans 1:16 (NLT)** <sup>16</sup> For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes—the Jew first and also the Gentile.
13. **Romans 3:23 (NLT)** <sup>23</sup> For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.
14. **Isaiah 53:6 (NLT)** <sup>6</sup> All of us, like sheep, have strayed away. We have left God's paths to follow our own. Yet the LORD laid on him the sins of us all.
15. **Romans 6:23 (NLT)** <sup>23</sup> For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.
16. **Hebrews 9:27–28 (NLT)** <sup>27</sup> And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment, <sup>28</sup> so also Christ was offered once for all time as a sacrifice to take away the sins of many people. He will come again, not to deal with our sins, but to bring salvation to all who are eagerly waiting for him.
17. **Romans 5:8 (NLT)** <sup>8</sup> But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.
18. **1 Peter 3:18 (NLT)** <sup>18</sup> Christ suffered for our sins once for all time. He never sinned, but he died for sinners to bring you safely home to God. He suffered physical death, but he was raised to life in the Spirit.
19. **Ephesians 2:8–9 (NLT)** <sup>8</sup> God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. <sup>9</sup> Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it.
20. **Titus 3:4–7 (NLT)** <sup>4</sup> But—When God our Savior revealed his kindness and love, <sup>5</sup> he saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit. <sup>6</sup> He generously poured out the Spirit upon us through

Jesus Christ our Savior. <sup>7</sup> Because of his grace he made us right in his sight and gave us confidence that we will inherit eternal life.

21. **John 1:10–13 (NLT)** <sup>10</sup> He came into the very world he created, but the world didn't recognize him. <sup>11</sup> He came to his own people, and even they rejected him. <sup>12</sup> But to all who believed him and accepted him, he gave the right to become children of God. <sup>13</sup> They are reborn—not with a physical birth resulting from human passion or plan, but a birth that comes from God.
22. **Revelation 3:20 (NLT)** <sup>20</sup> "Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in, and we will share a meal together as friends.
23. **1 John 5:13 (NLT)** <sup>13</sup> I have written this to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know you have eternal life.
24. **John 5:24 (NLT)** <sup>24</sup> "I tell you the truth, those who listen to my message and believe in God who sent me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life.
25. **1 Corinthians 3:16 (NLT)** <sup>16</sup> Don't you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in you?
26. **1 Corinthians 2:12 (NLT)** <sup>12</sup> And we have received God's Spirit (not the world's spirit), so we can know the wonderful things God has freely given us.
27. **Isaiah 41:10 (NLT)** <sup>10</sup> Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand.
28. **Philippians 4:13 (NLT)** <sup>13</sup> For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength.
29. **Lamentations 3:22–23 (NLT)** <sup>22</sup> The faithful love of the LORD never ends! His mercies never cease. <sup>23</sup> Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning.
30. **Numbers 23:19 (NLT)** <sup>19</sup> God is not a man, so he does not lie. He is not human, so he does not change his mind. Has he ever spoken and failed to act? Has he ever promised and not carried it through?
31. **Isaiah 26:3 (NLT)** <sup>3</sup> You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!
32. **1 Peter 5:7 (NLT)** <sup>7</sup> Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you.
33. **Romans 8:32 (NLT)** <sup>32</sup> Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else?
34. **Philippians 4:19 (NLT)** <sup>19</sup> And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.
35. **Hebrews 2:18 (NLT)** <sup>18</sup> Since he himself has gone through suffering and testing, he is able to help us when we are being tested.
36. **Psalms 119:9–11 (NLT)** <sup>9</sup> How can a young person stay pure? By obeying your word. <sup>10</sup> I have tried hard to find you— don't let me wander from your commands. <sup>11</sup> I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.
37. **Matthew 6:33 (NLT)** <sup>33</sup> Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.
38. **Luke 9:23 (NLT)** <sup>23</sup> Then he said to the crowd, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me.
39. **1 John 2:15–16 (NLT)** <sup>15</sup> Do not love this world nor the things it offers you, for when you love the world, you do not have the love of the Father in you. <sup>16</sup> For the world offers only a craving for physical pleasure, a craving for everything we see, and pride in our achievements and possessions. These are not from the Father, but are from this world.

40. **Romans 12:2 (NLT)** <sup>2</sup> Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.
41. **1 Corinthians 15:58 (NLT)** <sup>58</sup> So, my dear brothers and sisters, be strong and immovable. Always work enthusiastically for the Lord, for you know that nothing you do for the Lord is ever useless.
42. **Hebrews 12:3 (NLT)** <sup>3</sup> Think of all the hostility he endured from sinful people; then you won't become weary and give up.
43. **Mark 10:45 (NLT)** <sup>45</sup> *For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many."*
44. **2 Corinthians 4:5 (NLT)** <sup>5</sup> You see, we don't go around preaching about ourselves. We preach that Jesus Christ is Lord, and we ourselves are your servants for Jesus' sake.
45. **Proverbs 3:9–10 (NLT)** <sup>9</sup> Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. <sup>10</sup> Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine.
46. **2 Corinthians 9:6–7 (NLT)** <sup>6</sup> Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. <sup>7</sup> You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. "For God loves a person who gives cheerfully."
47. **Acts 1:8 (NLT)** <sup>8</sup> *But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."*
48. **Matthew 28:19–20 (NLT)** <sup>19</sup> *Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. <sup>20</sup> Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."*
49. **John 13:34–35 (NLT)** <sup>34</sup> *So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. <sup>35</sup> Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples."*
50. **1 John 3:18 (NLT)** <sup>18</sup> Dear children, let's not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions.
51. **Philippians 2:3–4 (NLT)** <sup>3</sup> Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too.
52. **1 Peter 5:5–6 (NLT)** <sup>5</sup> In the same way, you who are younger must accept the authority of the elders. And all of you, dress yourselves in humility as you relate to one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." <sup>6</sup> So humble yourselves under the mighty power of God, and at the right time he will lift you up in honor.
53. **Ephesians 5:3 (NLT)** <sup>3</sup> Let there be no sexual immorality, impurity, or greed among you. Such sins have no place among God's people.
54. **1 Peter 2:11 (NLT)** <sup>11</sup> Dear friends, I warn you as "temporary residents and foreigners" to keep away from worldly desires that wage war against your very souls.
55. **Leviticus 19:11 (NLT)** <sup>11</sup> "Do not steal. "Do not deceive or cheat one another.
56. **Acts 24:16 (NLT)** <sup>16</sup> Because of this, I always try to maintain a clear conscience before God and all people.
57. **Hebrews 11:6 (NLT)** <sup>6</sup> And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him.
58. **Romans 4:20–21 (NLT)** <sup>20</sup> Abraham never wavered in believing God's promise. In fact, his faith grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to God. <sup>21</sup> He was fully convinced that God is able to do whatever he promises.
59. **Galatians 6:9–10 (NLT)** <sup>9</sup> So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up. <sup>10</sup> Therefore, whenever we have the opportunity, we should do good to everyone—especially to those in the family of faith.

60. **Matthew 5:14–16 (NLT)** <sup>14</sup>“You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup>No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. <sup>16</sup>In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.
61. **1 John 5:11–12 (NLT)** <sup>11</sup>And this is what God has testified: He has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. <sup>12</sup>Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have God’s Son does not have life.
62. **John 16:24 (NLT)** <sup>24</sup>You haven’t done this before. Ask, using my name, and you will receive, and you will have abundant joy.
63. **1 Corinthians 10:13 (NLT)** <sup>13</sup>The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure.
64. **1 John 1:8–10 (NLT)** <sup>8</sup>If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. <sup>9</sup>But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. <sup>10</sup>If we claim we have not sinned, we are calling God a liar and showing that his word has no place in our hearts.
65. **Proverbs 3:5–7 (NLT)** <sup>5</sup>Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. <sup>6</sup>Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. <sup>7</sup>Don’t be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the LORD and turn away from evil.
66. **James 1:2–4 (NLT)** <sup>2</sup>Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. <sup>3</sup>For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. <sup>4</sup>So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing.
67. **Psalms 1:1–2 (NLT)** <sup>1</sup>Oh, the joys of those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or stand around with sinners, or join in with mockers. <sup>2</sup>But they delight in the law of the LORD, meditating on it day and night.
68. **Luke 14:25–26 (NLT)** <sup>25</sup>A large crowd was following Jesus. He turned around and said to them, <sup>26</sup>“If you want to be my disciple, you must, by comparison, hate everyone else—your father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even your own life. Otherwise, you cannot be my disciple.
69. **Colossians 3:1–2 (NLT)** Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God’s right hand. <sup>2</sup>Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth.
70. **Luke 5:16 (NLT)** <sup>16</sup>But Jesus often withdrew to the wilderness for prayer.
71. **Matthew 22:36–40 (NLT)** <sup>36</sup>“Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?” <sup>37</sup>Jesus replied, “‘You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.’ <sup>38</sup>This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup>A second is equally important: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ <sup>40</sup>The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments.”
72. **John 14:15 (NLT)** <sup>15</sup>“If you love me, obey my commandments.
73. **James 4:6 (NLT)** <sup>6</sup>And he gives grace generously. As the Scriptures say, “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.”
74. **Psalms 23:1 (NLT)** <sup>1</sup>The LORD is my shepherd; I have all that I need.
75. **John 3:16–17 (NLT)** <sup>16</sup>“For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. <sup>17</sup>God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him.
76. **Proverbs 1:1–7 (NLT)** These are the proverbs of Solomon, David’s son, king of Israel. <sup>2</sup>Their purpose is to teach people wisdom and discipline, to help them understand the insights of the wise. <sup>3</sup>Their purpose is to teach people to live disciplined and successful lives, to help them do what is right, just, and fair. <sup>4</sup>These proverbs will

give insight to the simple, knowledge and discernment to the young. <sup>5</sup> Let the wise listen to these proverbs and become even wiser. Let those with understanding receive guidance <sup>6</sup> by exploring the meaning in these proverbs and parables, the words of the wise and their riddles. <sup>7</sup> Fear of the LORD is the foundation of true knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.

77. **John 15:5 (NLT)** <sup>5</sup> “Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.
78. **John 3:30 (NLT)** <sup>30</sup> He (Jesus) must become greater and greater, and I (John the Baptist) must become less and less.
79. **John 10:10 (NLT)** <sup>10</sup> The thief’s purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life.
80. **Matthew 18:2–4 (NLT)** <sup>2</sup> Jesus called a little child to him and put the child among them. <sup>3</sup> Then he said, “I tell you the truth, unless you turn from your sins and become like little children, you will never get into the Kingdom of Heaven. <sup>4</sup> So anyone who becomes as humble as this little child is the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven.
81. **Proverbs 15:1 (NLT)** <sup>1</sup> A gentle answer deflects anger, but harsh words make tempers flare.
82. **Proverbs 15:22 (NLT)** <sup>22</sup> Plans go wrong for lack of advice; many advisers bring success.
83. **1 Peter 5:8 (NLT)** <sup>8</sup> Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.
84. **Romans 13:1–2 (NLT)** Everyone must submit to governing authorities. For all authority comes from God, and those in positions of authority have been placed there by God. <sup>2</sup> So anyone who rebels against authority is rebelling against what God has instituted, and they will be punished.
85. **Isaiah 55:8–9 (NLT)** <sup>8</sup> “My thoughts are nothing like your thoughts,” says the LORD. “And my ways are far beyond anything you could imagine. <sup>9</sup> For just as the heavens are higher than the earth, so my ways are higher than your ways and my thoughts higher than your thoughts.
86. **Isaiah 64:6 (NLT)** <sup>6</sup> We are all infected and impure with sin. When we display our righteous deeds, they are nothing but filthy rags. Like autumn leaves, we wither and fall, and our sins sweep us away like the wind.
87. **Psalms 119:105 (NLT)** <sup>105</sup> Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path.
88. **John 14:6 (NLT)** <sup>6</sup> Jesus told him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.
89. **Hebrews 4:16 (NLT)** <sup>16</sup> So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most.
90. **2 Chronicles 16:9 (NLT)** <sup>9</sup> The eyes of the LORD search the whole earth in order to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him. What a fool you have been! From now on you will be at war.”
91. **John 11:25 (NLT)** <sup>25</sup> Jesus told her, “I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying.
92. **Psalms 25:4-5 (NLT)** <sup>4</sup> Show me the right path, O LORD; point out the road for me to follow. <sup>5</sup> Lead me by your truth and teach me, for you are the God who saves me. All day long I put my hope in you.
